

Highlights of Cristo Rey Boston Technology Policy

1. All devices are the property of Cristo Rey Boston High School and are loaned to students for their use in school and work study related learning. (1.1-1.4 of Policy)
2. Misuse of the device or violation of the CRB Acceptable Use Policy could lead to loss of the privilege to use the device. (6.1-6.7)
3. The student is responsible for the device. If there is damage that is covered by the warranty, the student will be loaned another device until his/her device is repaired. If there is damage or loss that is not covered by the warranty, the student is responsible for repair/replacement of the device. (1.4)
4. All devices come with power cords. Students are responsible to charge their devices at home so that the device can work throughout the school day. The devices come with an extended battery live of 10-12 hours. Students may not bring their charging cords to school to plug in during class time. There will be charging stations in the school for students to use in emergencies to charge during lunch break or study periods. (3.3)
5. If a student needs to keep a device at school, they can bring the device at the end of the day to one of the charging stations, where it will be locked overnight. (7.2)
6. If a student loses their privilege to take a device home, they will return the device each day to a designated charging station, where it will be locked safe overnight. (3.1, 7.2)
7. Students will turn in their devices at the end of their school year in good condition. Students leaving the school via graduation, transfer or other reasons, will return the device to the school upon request. Failure to do so may mean the student does not participate in graduation or receive a diploma. It will also mean that no official records will be forwarded by CRB until the device is returned in good condition or replaced. (1.1-1.4, 10)
8. Only approved programs may be downloaded onto a device. Please see Technology Office for permission to add programs. (5.2)
9. All students understand that CRB may request to inspect a device loaned to a student at any time. (5.3)
10. The turn in process for devices is not complete until the device has been inspected by the Technology Office. (1.3)
